1	Primary care physician	OP Office	Initiate evaluation and treatment of epilepsy Make patient seizure-free on one medication, OR refer to general neurologist	0-3 months
2	General neurologist	OP Office	Complete initial evaluation Make patient seizure-free on medication, OR refer to Epilepsy Center	9-12 months
3	Team of specialty trained epileptologists and epilepsy surgeons	NAEC Accredited Epilepsy Center	Confirm diagnosis and rule out non-epileptic seizures Optimize medications Provide comprehensive diagnostic and pre-surgical evaluations Perform simple or complex epilepsy surgery Offer experimental treatments	6-12 months
4	Epilepsy Team	Epilepsy Center	Long term Management / follow-up	On-going
5	Therapy	OP Clinic	Provide speech therapy, vocational / social services, psychiatry	N/A
