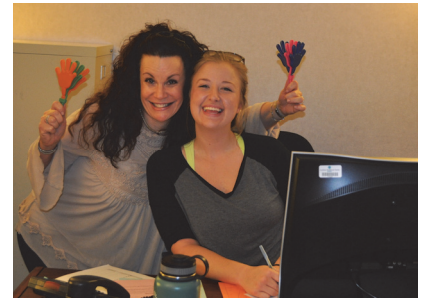

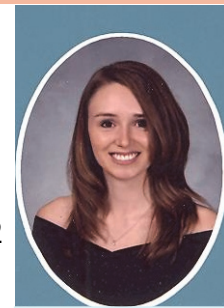

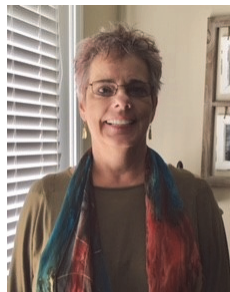

## 2018 ACE MODULES

The 2018 Annual Compliance Education (ACE) program will be available to students soon. The ACE program is a series of learning modules created to demonstrate that teammates and students within Atrium Health meet compliance requirements. Each year, all students in clinical programs are required to complete the ACE modules that are most relevant for their program of study. For the first time ever, students will use the Atrium Health learning management system through PeopleLink to complete ACE modules. This means that any records of modules completed as students can be retained if the student becomes an Atrium Health teammate. This also means that students who are current Atrium Health teammates will not need to repeat ACE modules! A program representative will soon provide students with information on how and when to access ACE modules for 2018.

The course takes approximately two hours and must be taken before attending the Heartcode BLS Online Skills Check. The test has to be completed in one sitting. 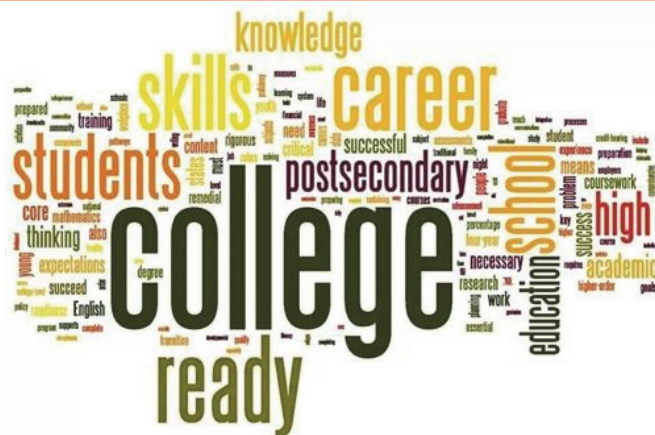
