Maureen S. Swick, MSN, PhD, RN, NEA-BC, is senior vice president and system nurse executive for Atrium Health, one of the most comprehensive and highly integrated not-for-profit healthcare systems in the nation. As a member of the executive council, Swick represents over 17,000 nurses across the organization to ensure consistency in nursing policy, strategy, practice and quality. She is also responsible for system-wide patient experience and security operations.

Swick has more than 30 years of experience in healthcare, joining Atrium Health in October 2017. Previously, she served as the chief executive officer of the American Organization of Nurse Executives (AONE). Additional leadership positions held throughout her career include senior vice president and chief nursing officer of the American Hospital Association (AHA) and senior vice president and chief nurse executive for Inova, a not-for-profit healthcare system based in Northern Virginia. Swick also served as a board member for both AONE and the AHA, and most recently as past president of AONE's board.

Throughout her career, Swick has received numerous awards, including the 2011 Outstanding Achievement Award-Nursing Spectrum and the AONE National Award in Leadership Informatics.

Swick earned her Ph.D. at Kennedy Western University and a Master of Science in nursing from Columbia University, New York.
