2019 ACE MODULES

The 2019 Annual Compliance Education (ACE) program are now available to students. The ACE program is a series of learning modules created to demonstrate that teammates and students within Atrium Health meet compliance requirements. Each year, all students in clinical programs are required to complete the ACE modules that are most relevant for their program of study. Current students should have received an email notifying them of this requirement. Please read the following points carefully to ensure you are compliant with this requirement.

- **Non-clinical students** (RN-BSN, General studies) are not required to complete ACE modules. They should not receive any further communication regarding this requirement.
- **Students who started clinical programs in the spring or summer of 2019** will not have to complete ACE modules again this year.
- Students starting clinical programs in Fall 2019 do not need to complete ACE modules until they start their program. They will not be granted access to the system until August 2019.
- **Students who are currently Atrium Health Teammates** will not complete ACE modules as a student. They should just complete the ACE modules assigned to them as a teammate.

FOR ALL OTHER STUDENTS, you can begin completing your ACE modules now. The deadline for completion is September 2019. In the event you need a reminder, the instructions for accessing the site are listed below. If you are not an Atrium Health teammate, follow the instructions below to log into the external system:

Enter C+Last 4 of Social Security Number+Birth Month, in this format: **C#####** in the User ID field. For example, if the last four of SSN is 1234 and your birth month is March, your User ID will be C123403. Remember this ID for future use.

Once you access the page, complete all assigned courses. Completion of all courses is mandatory, and you must achieve 80% on each posttest to pass. Multiple attempts are permitted.
