Information concerning your shot records is included in this packet, also. Two tuberculosis (TB) tests are required along with your immunization records (if available). You will contact Teammate Health at Atrium Health Union once you have attended orientation. Our teammate health nurse will be in charge of your immunizations in order to begin volunteering.

If you are chosen to attend an orientation after you have completed your interview, <u>you must</u> <u>dress appropriately for a professional organization.</u> This means no jeans or shorts can be worn <u>to orientation!</u> You will, also, need your social security number and your driver's license at this time.
