On-Demand Offerings

CFE offers academic department chairs and program directors the opportunity to choose offerings for their faculty and/or residents. These flexible offerings include workshops, small group discussions, large group lectures or individual consultations. Facilitators are CFE Fellows and other educators with significant experience in teaching, leadership and research.

Recognition of Excellence in Medical Education

CFE Teaching Awards are offered annually to recognize outstanding medical educators throughout Carolinas HealthCare System. Awards are based on teaching quality and contributions to medical education as judged by trainees in three areas:

- *Excellence in Medical Student Education*
- *Excellence in Resident Education*
- *Excellence in Simulation-Based Education*

Development of Educational Scholarship

A Grant for Research to Encourage & Advance Teaching (GREAT) in medical education is offered to support a single two-year educational project. Funding includes a \$10,000 award plus partial protection of faculty time.
