ADULT VOLUNTEERS | AGE 18+

To become an adult volunteer (18 and above), you will be asked to complete an application, provide references, attend a volunteer orientation (held twice a month) and provide documentation of immunizations and TB test results. Training for specific volunteer positions will be provided.

TEEN VOLUNTEER | AGES 15-17

To become a teen volunteer, you will be asked to complete an application, provide teacher references, provide documentation of TB test results and attend an orientation program (held twice a month).
