When Atrium Health's Levine Cancer Institute (LCI) was established in 2010, we had a vision: to break down barriers and transform cancer care. Over the last 9 years, we've opened more than 25 locations throughout the Carolinas, giving people access to world-class cancer care right where they live. And now, Levine Cancer Institute II (LCI II), an extension of our research and academic headquarters in Charlotte, will enhance services throughout our system.

Patients sit in recliners as they receive their infusion treatments. LCI has 72 infusion chairs, including 12 that are reserved for Phase 1 clinical trial participants. And now, LCI II has 60 new infusion chairs that will be used to serve our hematology patients.



12 isolation bays
(8 new)

Isolation bays protect our most vulnerable patients from germs. In LCI II, 8 isolation bays were built with anterooms to offer even greater protection.

Investing in Cancer Care

Our growth is part of Atrium Health's \$150 million investment in expanding cancer care in the Carolinas. The project, which was supported by a \$25 million commitment from the Leon Levine Foundation, includes:

- \$5 million to enhance operations at LCI, including a 21,000-square-foot renovation
- \$20 million in inpatient renovations at Carolinas Medical Center, including a new 32-bed hematologic unit and renovations to an existing 32,000-square-foot space
- \$125 million to build LCI II, which adds 260,000 square feet to our flagship cancer center

Our Patient and Family Advisory Council was involved in many important decisions about the building's design and flow. Based on their feedback, LCI II prominently features a chapel, and we've implemented a centralized lab and registration process for the entire headquarters.
