Empowering Collaboration for Community Health Solutions

The Community Partnered Research Award supports partnerships between non-profit community organizations and academic faculty in the Southeast Region of Advocate Health. Its goal is to build trust, develop skills, and promote research that addresses important community health challenges. The award encourages collaborative projects aimed at improving health outcomes and reducing disparities. Both new and ongoing partnerships are welcome to apply.

Who Can Apply?

- Community Partnered Researcher: Must work for a non-profit community organization or local government agency serving the Southeast Region of Advocate Health.
- Academic Faculty Researcher: Must hold faculty rank within Advocate Health institutions, including Atrium Health, Atrium Health Navicent, Atrium Health Wake Forest Baptist, and Wake Forest University School of Medicine, and Wake Forest University.

Award Details

- Academic Faculty Compensation: Support for 10% effort.
- Ommunity Partner Compensation: \$10,000 grant.
- Project Period: All funds must be used within one year; no-cost extensions are not permitted.

 December 31, 2026
