- Organizational Mission Statement (200-character max)
- Previous Funding from the Philip L. Van Every Foundation (100-character max)
 - o Please list date, amount and purpose up to five years if applicable.
- Project Summary (40-character max)
- Proposed Amount of Request (20-character max)
- Program/Project Description (500-character max)
 - Briefly describe the proposed project or program and its purpose.
- Population Serviced for this Project/Program (1000-character max)
 - o Describe the population served, including number of people, ethnicity, gender and age.
- Geographic Region Served
 - North Carolina or South Carolina
- Goals and Outcomes (800-character max)
 - o Briefly describe the program goals and desired outcomes.
- Type of Gift
 - o Program or Project, Capital, Scholarship (non-individual), Endowment, or Operating
 - Capital Projects must include:
 - -Total Campaign Goal (20-character max)
 - -Total Funds Raised to Date (20-character max)
 - -Estimated Campaign Completion Date (10-character max)
