Editing Services

We provide editing support to improve grant proposals (e.g., to NIH), including but not limited to:

- Editing for grammar, punctuation, style, clarity, and logical flow of ideas
- Editing text to align with funding announcement/sponsor guidelines
- Polishing text for responsiveness to reviewer comments
- Drafting/editing letters of support
- Providing consultations for early career faculty to help with proposal development

In addition, our team has experience supporting a variety of large and complex grant proposal mechanisms (e.g., PCORI, NIH Center Grants, NIH Training Grants, DoD, Associations, and Societies).
