Updates to the 2011 -12 Cabarrus College Catalog are made periodically throughout the academic year. Changes made to the catalog are documented below.

July 14, 2011

P. 65: The background check fee and experiential learning fees were added to the list of fees.

Original Text: NSG 301 - Health Assessment

This course examines holistic health assessment of culturally diverse clients across the lifespan. It includes comprehensive health assessment and communication of health assessment findings. Credit: 3 hours. *This course is offered in a web-based format.* Offered spring semester.
