## CABARRUS COLLEGE ENROLLMENT EXCEEDS 500 FOR 2009-10

**Concord, NC, February 15, 2010-** Cabarrus College of Health Sciences enrollment increased to 507 students for the 2009-2010 academic year, with the addition of 97 new students for the spring semester. This is the first time that College enrollment has eclipsed 500 for an academic year, and represents an 8% increase compared to the previous academic year. A total of 410 students enrolled for the spring semester, an increase of 14% compared to the Spring 2009 semester.

Other interesting statistics related to enrollment include:

- The average age of enrolled students was 28.
- 32% of enrolled students were from Cabarrus County; 24% were from Mecklenburg County; and 20% were from Rowan County.
- $\bullet$  Over 900 applications for admission were received during 2009-2010, an increase of 20%.

Chancellor Dianne Snyder stated, "We continue to experience strong enrollment growth in our bachelors and associate degree programs. We are receiving a number of applications from people who have worked in the financial services, manufacturing and racing industries, looking to transition into healthcare.
