Surgical Technology Program Recognized with Galaxy Star Award

Concord, N.C. — The Surgical Technology program at Cabarrus College was recognized by the Association of Surgical Technologists (AST) with the Galaxy Star Award in 2012. The award is presented to surgical technology programs that have 75% or more of their students registered as members of AST. Of the 426 programs in the United States only 285 received the Galaxy award.

The AST Galaxy Award is a program to recognize surgical technology programs that promote their students future success in the field by encouraging membership in their national professional organization - The Association of Surgical Technologists. Galaxy Stars receive special recognition at the national conference, in the *Surgical Technologist Journal*, and in the Instructors Newsletter. Programs also receive a gift certificate from AST to use for materials and resources to enhance the classroom, and a certificate of recognition.
