



Pharmacy Technology Program Earns National Accreditation

Cabarrus College of Health Sciences is proud to announce our Associate Degree Pharmacy Technology Program is now accredited by the American Society of Health-System Pharmacists, the only nationally-recognized accrediting body for pharmacy technician education and training programs.

Our program is the only ASHP-accredited program in the metro-Charlotte area, and the distinction will transfer to the newly-formed Pharmacy Technician Accreditation Commission (PTAC) in late 2014.

An associate's degree in pharmacy technology is required by NC law to validate the work of other pharmacy technicians in hospitals. Associate degree pharmacy technicians are typically hired at higher salaries and job ranks than technicians without the degree. There is a high demand for qualified pharmacy technicians in both retail and hospital settings, and the profession is set to grow by 32 percent nationwide by the year 2018.
