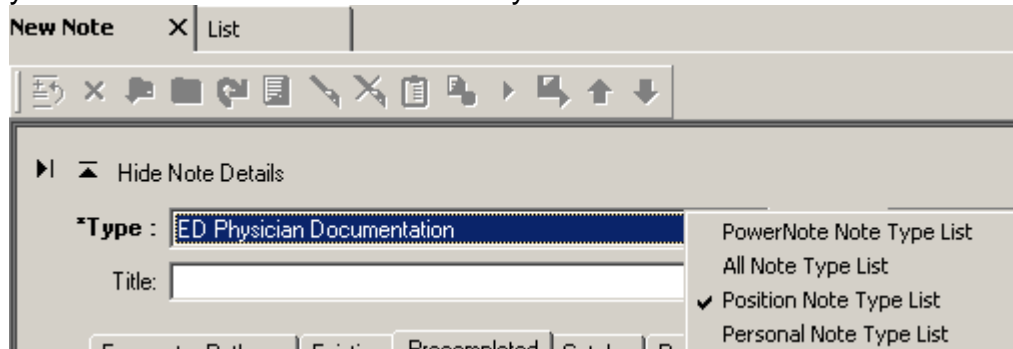
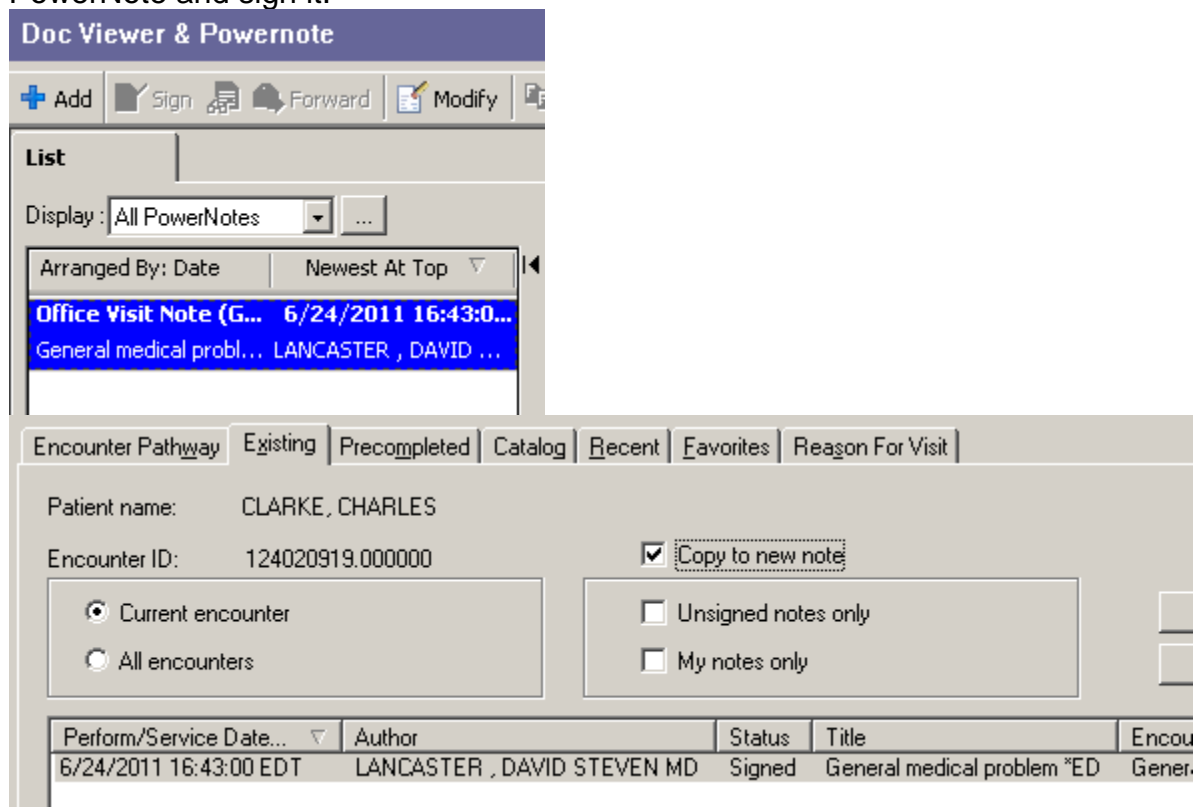


To change your default back to ED Physician Documentation, in PowerNotes Add window, right click and click on Position Note Type List. This should limit your default choices to one: ED Physician Documentation.



1. Open Doc Viewer&PowerNote window in patient's chart.
2. Click on Add+ button
3. Right click on Type field.
4. Click on Position Note Type List

To copy your Office Visit Type notes to ED Physician Documentation type notes, you will need to add a new note, copying the old note into the new PowerNote and sign it.



1. Open Doc Viewer&PowerNote window in patient's chart.
2. Click on Add+ button
3. Click on Existing tab.
4. Find your PowerNote in the list. Click once on it.

5. Click on Copy to new note
6. Click on OK.
7. The auto-populate note will open. In the bottom portion of the window, the previously auto-populated data will appear. You could include more from the top window if desired. If not, or when through adding, click OK.

8. If you want to change any of your documentation, you could do it. however, the old note will still be viewable for comparison of any change.
9. Verify that all pulled in as desired. Any launching of functionality would need to be repeated as it will not pull in. I am not sure if you did that from within your PowerNotes. i.e. prescriptions. Follow up, etc. however know that all you documented from the previous note via this method is saved to the visit. So unless you want it in your PowerNote there is no need to repeat.
