

## MLP Ordering with Physician Cosigning Orders

This document should be used when an MLP is ordering and needs to supply Supervising Physicians name for co-signature. **PLEASE NOTE: SUPERVISING PHYSICIAN CARRIES FORWARD FROM PATIENT TO PATIENT. IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE ORDERING PROVIDER TO ENSURE THAT THE CORRECT SUPERVISING PHYSICIAN IS ON THE ORDER. RECOMMENDATION IS TO CHANGE THE SUPERVISING PHYSICIAN AT THE BEGINNING OF EACH SHIFT (ON THE FIRST ORDER).**

- Before MLP signs the order - review the Order Details
- Select the Binoculars in the Supervising Physician box
- Search for appropriate physician.
- Sign Order

- After MLP refreshes screen order will display as “ordered”
- There should be a Caduceus displayed indicating Physician co-signature.

Look for Caduceus symbol. It indicates that a Physician co-signature is required.
