

## Crawley Memorial Hospital

Crawley Memorial Hospital, part of the Cleveland County HealthCare System, has been certified as a Long Term Acute Care Hospital (LTACH) by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services. It is one of only eight LTACH facilities in North Carolina.

This certification means that Crawley is equipped and staffed to manage critically ill and medically complex patients for a longer period of time than traditional acute care hospitals. The average length of stay for a patient in an LTACH is 25 days.

The care team at Crawley treats patients who have conditions such as chronic obstructive pulmonary disease, major trauma, complex wounds, heart disease, complex orthopaedic conditions, multi-system failure, neurological illness, spinal cord or other injuries, or tracheotomies.

Crawley's patients come from all over the region, including Cleveland, Rutherford, Gaston, Burke and Lincoln counties of North Carolina and the Upstate area of South Carolina.

In addition to 41 long-term acute care beds, Crawley has 10 short-term skilled nursing beds. When patients are ready to leave the hospital but need a little extra time to recover before going home, this is an option. Services provided to short-term skilled nursing patients include rehabilitation after joint replacement surgery, post-surgical therapy for a fracture such as a broken hip, and stroke therapy.
