Course Objectives: Upon completion of this workshop, you will be able to

- Relate the distinguishing factor that differentiates the peripheral IV line from the central IV line
- Discuss the reasons why veins in the lower extremities and on the flexor surfaces of the joints are not routinely used as IV sites
- Describe nursing measures that may be used to make a patient more comfortable physically and emotionally prior to having an IV started
- Demonstrate various methods to promote dilation of the vein
- Relate factors to be considered when selecting the IV site
- Relate factors to be considered when selecting the type and size of the IV catheter
- Demonstrate aseptic techniques used when inserting and IV catheter
- Discuss information documented regarding the IV start on the appropriate medical record form
- Describe common complications of IV therapy
