CMC-Union Ambulatory Surgery Center



To meet the growing outpatient surgical needs of those in the western part of Union County, Carolinas Medical Center-Union has begun construction on an Ambulatory Surgery Center.

The 9,000-square-foot Ambulatory Surgery Center will be located in Union West Medical Plaza on Highway 74 in Indian Trail. CMC-Union anticipates that the Center, which is currently being built with one operating room, will be used primarily for outpatient surgeries by seven specialties, including:

- Ear, Nose and Throat
- Ophthalmology
- Gynecology
- Orthopaedics
- General Surgery
- Plastic Surgery
- Urology

The Ambulatory Surgery Center is expected to open by the end of 2009.

Pending Certificate of Need

In an effort to create a more efficient setting where surgeons could more easily schedule patients in need of outpatient surgery, CMC-Union filed a Certificate of Need with the State of North Carolina on March 17, 2009 to add an additional operating room at the Ambulatory Surgery Center. This project would require 1,000 square feet of additional space and the total cost of the project is estimated to be approximately \$1.1 million.

CMC-Union expects a decision from the state in August 2009. If approved, the second operating room would be completed as soon as possible the following year.
