

# Temporary Student Opportunities FAQs

## Atrium Health

### What positions are available?

We are currently hiring students to supplement the efforts to combat the coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19). These are temporary positions for Nurse Aide I and Student Aide roles. The Student Aide roles will be responsible for assisting on the inpatient units but will not deliver direct patient care.

***Please note, due to the nature of these roles students maybe possibly come in contact with patients who are positive for COVID-19.***

### Who is eligible for these positions?

These positions are designed for students in local colleges and universities who are interested in gaining experience in patient care. All new teammates must have a high school diploma, or equivalent, and a current CPR certification from the American Heart Association. The Nurse Aide I (NA I) role requires the NA I certification from the DFS Nurse Aide Registry prior to your start date.

### Where will these roles work?

These roles will be deployed to the areas with the highest needs and therefore will be required to float to different Atrium Health facilities within Charlotte and the surrounding areas.

### What hours will these roles work?

These roles will be a PRN status, and students will need to work only 16 hours per month to maintain their active employment status. Additional hours may be available depending on patient census and unit needs. Students in these positions should anticipate working rotating shifts including nights and weekends to ensure patient units are staffed.

***Please note that any hours worked in these roles will be strictly for employment purposes and will not count towards clinical requirements for any academic program.***
