## **Instructions**

Atrium Health employees and graduates of Cabarrus College and Carolinas College are eligible for fast track admission.

## To Apply:

• Submit the completed Fast Track Admission Form and any other required documents to:

- If you are a <u>current student</u>, you may utilize the Fast Track any time during your final semester **and** within one year of graduation.
- If you are an <u>Atrium Health employee</u>, you may apply at any time. Please refer to the current Cabarrus College catalog for priority deadlines and semester start dates. <u>You will need to submit official transcripts from all post-secondary institutions</u> attended.
- If you are an **Atrium Health employee** applying to **Medical Assistant**:
  - You will need to submit official transcripts from high school and all post-secondary institutions attended, including evidence of completion of high school or college level Algebra I, Algebra II or Geometry, and Biology, AND
  - Either SAT (at least 430 Reading, 380 Math) or ACT (at least a score of 18) test scores AND
  - A Professional Reference Form completed by a current supervisor
- If you are applying to <u>Medical Imaging</u>: You will need to submit an official transcript showing completion of an Associate
  Degree or equivalent in a primary imaging science discipline with a minimum GPA of 2.5 AND a copy of your ARRT license.
- If you are an Atrium Health employee applying to RN to BSN:
  - You will need to submit official transcripts showing completion of an ADN degree from an accredited program, with a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 AND a current unencumbered, active license to practice as an RN.
- If you are an **Atrium Health employee** applying to **MSN**:
  - You will need to submit official transcripts showing completion of a BSN degree from an accredited program, with a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 AND a current unencumbered, active license to practice as an RN.
- If you are applying to <u>Surgical Technology AAD</u>: You must include a letter of recommendation from a current, immediate supervisor AND two letters of recommendation from surgeons AND a completed Credit for Life Experience application, along with \$150 fee for each course you wish to receive credit for.
