Mammography

Mammography classes are designed for the American Registry of Radiologic Technologists-registered (ARRT) radiologic technologist to advance their knowledge and skill within the modality of mammography.

The mammography classes include both a theory class and practicum class. The didactic component of the theory class focuses on the fundamentals of mammography, breast imaging equipment and techniques for image quality. Breast anatomy, pathologies and strategies for communicating with patients are also part of the curriculum. In the practicum class, clinical emphasis will continue to develop and demonstrate competency in the performance of mammography procedures and patient care skills. Patient safety concerns are addressed throughout the class as it relates to radiation safety and an overall emphasis on patient care.
